Introduction:

- I. SALVATION IS BY THE DEATH OF CHRIST.
 1. He died voluntarily.
 2. He died vicariously.
- II. SALVATION IS DELIVERANCE.
 1. This present evil world is destined for utter destruction.
 2. This present evil world holds the sinner as a captive.
 3. The death of Christ delivers us from this present evil world.
- III. SALVATION IS THE WILL OF GOD.
 1. The works and will of man is powerless to deliver.
 2. The will of God is sovereign in bring deliverance.
- IV. SALVATION IS TO THE GLORY OF GOD.
 1. Not to the glory of man.
 2. But to the glory of God—since it is totally a work of God.
