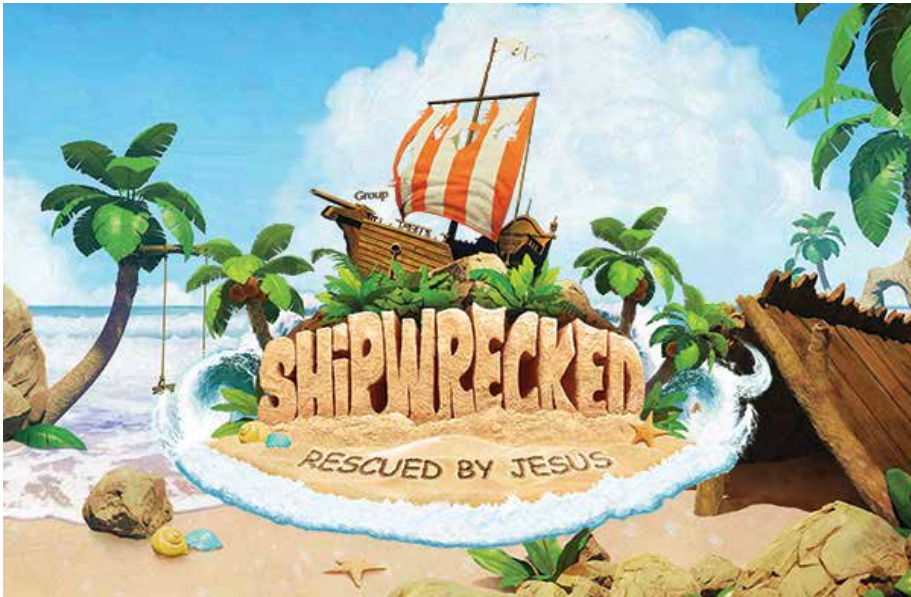

Holy Communion – “This Holy Mystery”: Beginning July 1st

Dr. David Daniel, Minister of Music & Worship Arts, will lead a study about the sacrament of communion as understood in our United Methodist Church. Holy Communion is about realizing the presence of Christ in our lives for the gathered community and your personal call from Christ. The study will explore the mystery, the table servants, the table itself and the liturgy of the service. Join Dr. Daniel in room F-147, located on the 1st floor of the Family Life Center, on Sundays at 9:30 a.m. beginning on July 1st and ending on August 5th. If you would like to order a book the cost is \$13 or also available on Amazon to download to your Kindle for \$10. Please register by June 18th in order to have the books in time for the first class.

Another option for summer study, **“Paul’s Missionary Journey’s”**, begins on June 17th. Join Rev. C. Kay Fuino on select Sunday evenings in June and July for an overview of Paul and his missionary journeys. The class will cover the sequence of events in a historical text, and comparison of those events with other known events from relevant sources. The class will meet from 5:30 to 6:30 in rooms F-204/205, located on the 2nd floor of the Family Life Center, on June 17th, June 24th, July 1st, July 8th and conclude on July 22nd. There is no book required for the study other than a study Bible. Please register with Tracy Brinker for this class so we know how many handouts to create.

Supporting Our Troops During the Summer Months

While we are enjoying summer outdoor activities and going on vacation, our service members deployed in the Middle East are enduring extreme heat conditions in the summer months when daily temperatures can exceed 100 degrees by 9:00 a.m. They are in fairly remote locations without a U.S. PX or other amenities and do not have the ability to go purchase more items when needed. This makes it especially difficult for the younger troops.

Through the months of June and July the **Hugs for Soldiers** ministry is collecting items requested by our troops. Donated items will be packed and shipped overseas as soon as we receive them. When a service member is deployed, anything they receive from home is greatly appreciated.

The wish list items for male and female troops:

- Sunscreen/after sun (lotion & pump spray only – no aerosols)
- Socks – white or black crew and ankle socks to keep feet clean and dry
- Personal care items
- Over-the-counter medications – allergies, pain reliever, cough drops, antacids, eye drops, etc.
- Letters and cards of thanks for the sacrifices they are making for us.
- In addition, please consider making a monetary donation to support the shipment of these packages.

Donation boxes are located on the stage in Fellowship Hall and inside the back entrance to the Family Life Center. Thank you for your generosity.

Stop by the church's library, located on the 2nd floor of the Family Life Center, to check out the new books and audio books that have been added to our collection. New titles that have been added recently include:

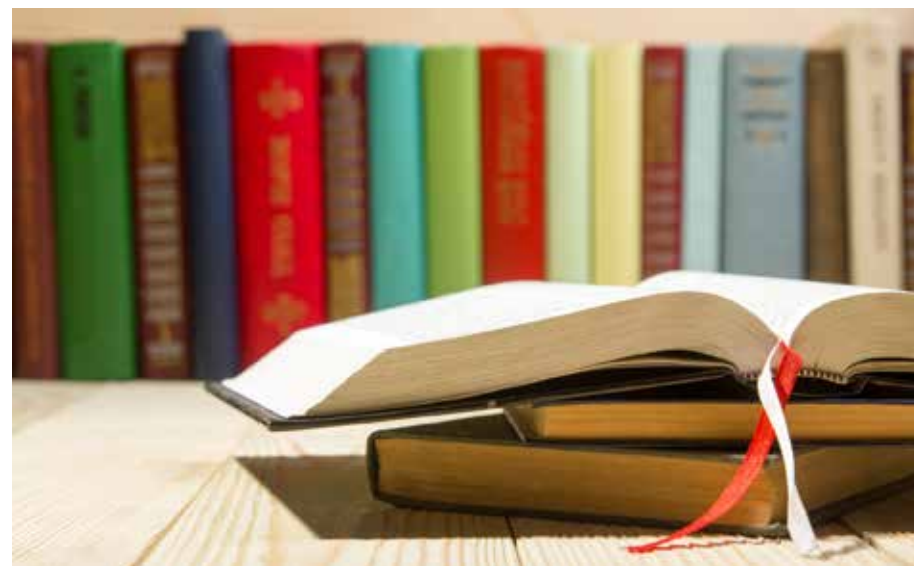
- **Plain Wisdom** by Cindy Woodsmall and Miriam Flaud;
