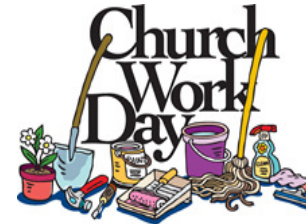
### Kentucky Changers
