**Be it further resolved** that, if necessary, the Board of Elim Church be authorized to increase our total mortgage debt to no more than \$5.5 million.


#### Resolution #2



## Finances for Building Addition:

The preliminary costing of the renovation and addition of approximately 10,000 square feet is \$3 million. When we have working drawings, we will be able to present a more accurate figure. The plan that the Board is recommending is that we move forward with a capital campaign. Construction would commence when \$1 million of building fund money has been received. A further \$1 million would be raised through pledges over the three year campaign and the balance would be cared for through our mortgage. Our mortgage is currently \$4.6 million and would not exceed \$5.5 million of total mortgage indebtedness.
