From The Desk of The Pastor

"Spiritual Warfare"

In our presentation so far on the subject of **Spiritual Warfare** we have discussed the **universal conflict** between good and evil; between **God and Satan**. We have discussed the **attributes** and the **names of God**. In this edition we will present information on **elect angels**, or good angels. The **two classifications** of angels in the Bible are **good** and **evil**. The good are called "elect" or "holy" (1 Timothy 5:11; Matthew 25:31). They worship and serve God with unwavering allegiance. The **evil angels** are called **demons**, and with their leader **Satan** they oppose God and His people. These **two armies** are engaged in a **cosmic warfare** beyond human comprehension, affecting the course of nations and the world (Matthew 25:41; 12:26-28). Let's answer some key questions about angels.

1. **What are they?** They are **personal spiritual beings** with **intelligence, will, and emotions** (Matthew 8:29; 1 Peter 1:12; Luke 2:13; 8:28-31). They are spirit beings **without physical bodies** (Hebrews 1:14). They sometimes reveal themselves to humans in human bodies (Genesis 18:3). 2. **What do they know?** They are not all-knowing like God (Matthew 24:36), but have **greater knowledge than humans**. They were created as **an order higher** than humans; they **know the Bible** and the world better than humans; they have gained knowledge by **watching all of human history** (James 2:19). 3. **Where did they come from?** Angels were all created by Christ simultaneously and innumerable (Colossians 1:16; Hebrews 12:22). 4. **What are their types?** As before stated there are two general categories, good and bad, elect and evil, **fallen** and **unfallen**.

Our focus, holy angels fall into special classes, with certain ones being named. **Michael** the archangel is likely the **head of the holy angels** (Daniel 10:21; 12:1; 1 Thessalonians 4:16; Jude 9; Revelation 12:7-10). **Gabriel** is the principal **messenger** of God (Daniel 8:16; 9:21; Luke 1:18-19; Luke 1:26-38). Some angels are called **Cherubim**, and are living creatures who defend the holiness of God (Genesis 3:24; Exodus 25:18, 20; Ezekiel 1:1-18). **Seraphim** are another class mentioned in Isaiah 6:2-7. Their function is to praise God as His messengers on earth. Praise God for His ministering angels. **Throughout scripture** there are many instances where God's holy **angels protect and minister to God's people** on His behalf. There's no reason to believe that they have ceased in this function. However, nowhere in scripture does it say that believers can command angels or post angels where they want them. They get their instructions from God and not man. Ours is only to ask God for His divine protection and leave the details to Him and His holy angels.

Next time we will discuss **fallen angels** or demons, along with their leader **Satan**.






