Thank you for supporting Family Promise of Hawai'i by attending this fun and crazy event. Who could imagine a buffet of chocolate sweets!? We at Family Promise have been a beneficiary of this event for the past three years, and we truly appreciate Emmanuel's outreach ministry and your attendance. The proceeds raised will stay right here in Kailua to support the families in our Windward program.



Family Promise of Hawai'i (FPH) partners with over 65 interfaith congregations and 1,500 volunteers to shelter, feed, and support homeless families with children. Over 80% of our guests transition from homelessness to sustainable housing, usually in three to four months. Over 70% of guest families are employed by the time they leave our program.

Family Promise operates at one-third the cost of traditional shelters since most work is performed by volunteers. Guests sleep at congregations in the evening

and work with a case manager during the day at our Windward and Chinatown day centers. In addition to food and shelter, FPH helps guests with their housing, employment, health, education, transportation, and family financial management (budgeting) needs.

We appreciate your support and look forward to serving together until every child enjoys a home!
