Congregational template for candidacy for the vocational diaconate

such as the date of admission to postulancy.

Candidacy is a time of education and formation in preparation for ordination to the vocational diaconate. The canons call for a letter of continued support for the postulant from the postulant's congregation. This letter is to be dated and signed by at least two thirds of the vestry/bishop's committee, the priest of the congregation, and attested by the clerk.

The following wording would suffice as a minimum statement:
In accordance with Canon III.6.4.a, we the congregation of, offer our support for as he/she pursues a call to the vocational diaconate. We are also willing to support him/her financially and to actively support him/her in other ways as he/she prepares for ordination.
