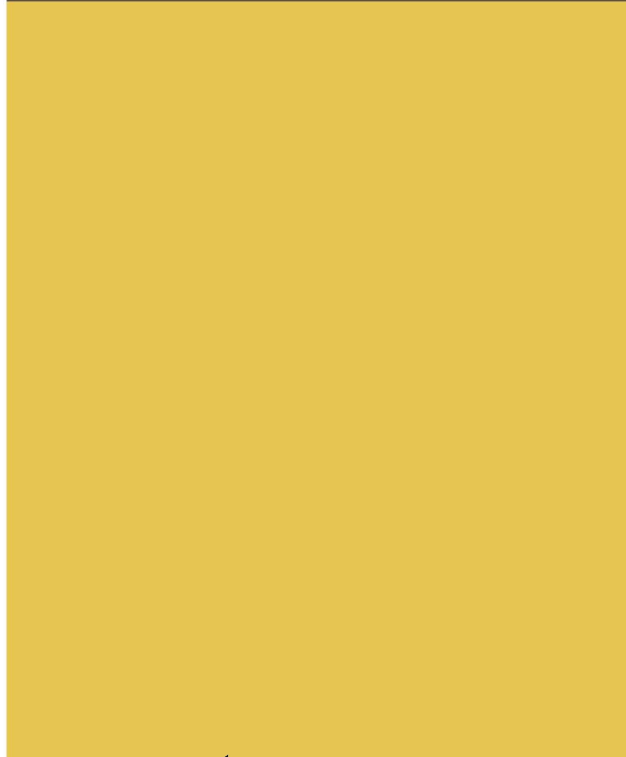
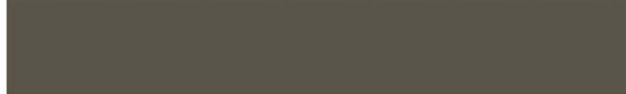
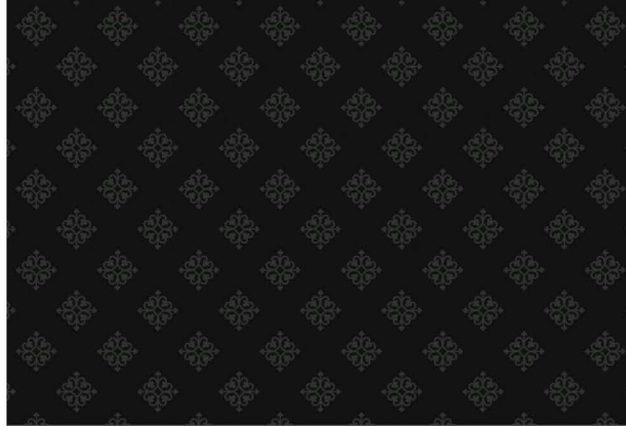

## Senior Ministries

### Senior Luncheon

One of the highlights of Senior Ministries is the monthly luncheon, held at noon on the last Thursday of the month. Typically, all are invited to bring a dish to pass, although occasionally the group meets at a restaurant to celebrate a special occasion. Every month's meal is followed by a time of fellowship, featuring a guest entertainer—ranging from musicians to mimes to special interest speakers and anything in between.

## Bible Studies

Our church offers a number of Bible study opportunities for adults, most of which meet weekly. We also offer Adult Bible Fellowship (ABF) classes on Sundays as a way to foster small communities among such a large church. For a full schedule of available studies and classes, please give us a call or stop by the church office during the week!

The following are studies are designed specifically with seniors in mind:

- A **Bible study for men** meets weekly on Tuesdays at 8 a.m. at the home of Ben Martin.
- At 1 p.m. on the third Wednesday of every month, a **Bible study for men and women** meets at the home of Peggy Carlson or the home of Ben and Donna Martin. Details can be found in the Sunday bulletin the week prior.
- The **Primetimers ABF** for 60-somethings+ meets Sundays at 10:45 a.m.
- **Meridians**, an ABF for 50-somethings+, also meets Sundays at 10:45 a.m.

## Other Resources

Whatever your gifts or needs, we would love to help you get involved with the ministries here at EFCL. Listed below are some resources that offer assistance and are designed to help you maintain fellowship with the church body outside the walls of the church building.

- **Hope Visitation** is our church ministry to shut-ins, and seniors are invited to participate. A list of names of those who would like to receive visitors is available upon asking.
