The following letter was mailed to our congregation this past week. I want to share it again below, to make sure everyone has a chance to read it.

Friends of Evergreen United Methodist Church,

Today, I am writing to share that God is calling me to a new place. Effective July 1, 2020, Bishop Bruce Ough has appointed me to serve as Senior Pastor of First United Methodist Church in Watertown, South Dakota.

When I arrived in Wahpeton nearly 6 years ago, I never could have expected the journey we've been on together. We have shared in laughter and tears, celebrations and grief, surprises and miracles. We have challenged one another to be our best selves, and we have worked to enact the plans God has for us as a community of faith. I cannot begin to express how grateful I am for the time and ministry that we have shared together at Evergreen United Methodist Church.

In the midst of that gratitude, I find myself living the tension between grief of leaving this place and community I love... and anticipation for what God may have in store for me and First United Methodist Church of Watertown.
