We will also be providing food baskets for each family.

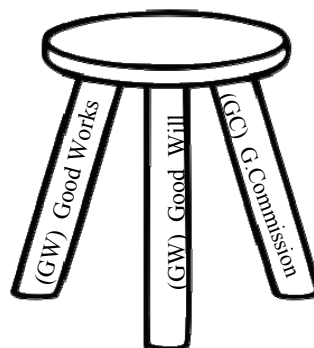

Gottfried Reichel was born on March 9, 1930, in east Germany. He was "born again" May 2, 1948. In his early years, Bro. Gottfried belonged to the "Hitler Youth" organization. Following the war, he came across the American lines at Munich. He got a job as a "barracks boy". It was here that he became acquainted with a soldier who was a member of the body of Christ, from San Angelo, Texas. This soldier studied with Gottfried and led him to Christ.

The Lord has used his servant Gottfried in a powerful way since his conversion in 1948 there in Munich. He preached for the Munich-Laim congregation from 1953-1968. For 35 years, from June 1965 – December 2000, he was the regular speaker for the German Radio Ministry, a weekly broadcast aired over Radio Luxembourg. With its 600,000 watts, it was the most powerful commercial radio station in the world. This German-language program has received mail responses from listeners in 39 countries located on four continents: Europe, Asia, Africa, and America. Over 500 known new births through water and the Spirit have been reported as a result of these broadcasts.

In recent years, Gottfried has been working to digitize these sermons, making them available through the internet to people all around the world.

Fairmont Park has long been associated with Gottfried and the wonderful work that he has done through the years. "To God be the glory!!"
