



Pathway to Renewal

A group of people, including myself, made a proposal to commission a Pathway to Renewal Team at the Church Council meeting last October. This new plan was initiated by the reality of our budget deficit in 2012 and a new year as well, but our current situation has led us to consider the need of a spiritual renewal process for the future of our church rather than leadership or administrative development program which we have done in the past. A unique and good thing about Pathway to Renewal is that it is not a consultation program, but it is a “renewal movement” based on spiritual guidance and coaching. Our church leadership team, Pathway to Renewal Team, and the Church Council will work together to brainstorm and initiate work ideas and plans with the guidance of our spiritual coach, Rev. Dan Smith. For the renewal process, he pointed out two ways: a long term spiritual renewal goal and a short term maintenance and functioning goal. We decided to begin our long term goal by having a Survey on Friday, February 22 and Saturday, February 23. Our spiritual coach will visit our church and lead small group sessions on both Friday and Saturday. Each participant can have a chance to share and voice honest opinions about our church, especially about their understandings on the ministries, missions, and their worship experiences. For a short term goal, we plan to have a stewardship campaign in April of this year. This stewardship campaign will be another great opportunity for all of us to share what our church has done in our mission, spiritual education and ministries in the past and check in on our present ministries and envision together the future of our church through this opportunity.

Hello and blessing to everyone. The first half of our 2012 fiscal year ended on December 31, 2012 and we want everyone to be aware of our income and expenses. Going forward, we will be reinstating our weekly income and expense data in the Sunday bulletin.

As you can see from the information above, our expenses are exceeding our income. We have been drawing from our reserve accounts but we cannot keep drawing down our reserves. Finance and Church Council will be looking for ways to begin cutting our expenses in order to stop this trend. Everyone is invited to attend the next Church Council meeting on February 26 at 6:30 pm in Spencer to participate in developing a plan of action.



What can each of us do to help? For those that pledge, try to stay current with your pledge giving. If you are not currently pledging to the church, please prayerfully consider giving to your church on a regular basis (weekly or monthly). Passions for Christ: Outreach Ministries

Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of injustice...to share bread with the hungry.

Isaiah 58:6-7

Isaiah 58 calls us to challenge our spiritual practices asking - do our spiritual disciplines bring us to a point of humility or are they a means to serve our own interests? The noun translated "fast" or "a fasting" is *tsom* in the Hebrew and *nesteia* in the Greek language. It means the voluntary abstinence from food. The literal Hebrew translation would be "not to eat." The literal Greek means "no food." Through Isaiah, God redefines what it means to fast. Fasting means to stand up against injustice and oppression, to feed the hungry and shelter the homeless, to clothe the naked. It is this type of fasting that breaks the yoke of bondage and brings about a release of God's presence, power, and provision in the lives of those being served as well as those who are serving.



I had the pleasure last month server alongside Rosanne, Ruby, Wayde, Luke and others as we volunteered to serve meals to the homeless at Loaves and Fishes. When I asked Rosanne why she spends her Saturdays volunteering she responded jubilantly exclaiming, "I love working at Loaves and Fishes. It's part of my mission to feed the hungry. I probably get more out of it than the people getting the food. We're working with St. Mark's, Rancho Cordova, and St. Andrew's. I'll encourage anybody to participate in this mission because it's your opportunity to give to a population and get so much more in return."



If you offer your food to the hungry and satisfy the needs of the afflicted,

then your light shall rise in the darkness and your gloom be like the noonday. *Isaiah 58:10*

Without passing judgment, and in a spirit of love and hospitality, Loaves & Fishes feeds the hungry and shelters the homeless providing an oasis of welcome, safety, and cleanliness for homeless men, women and children. "We recognize the dignity and spiritual destiny of each person, and hope by our attitude of hospitality and love, to nourish not only the physical needs of those who come to Loaves & Fishes, but also their spiritual need for love, acceptance, respect, and friendship." 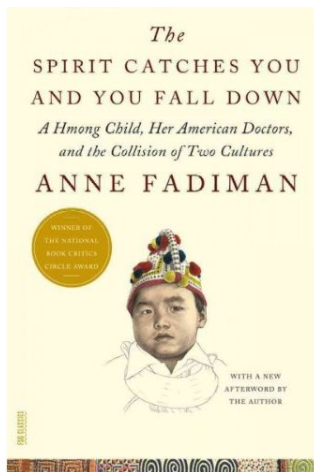

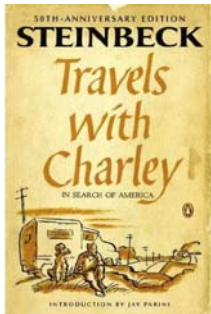
Joanne Cossairt's 80th Birthday Celebration

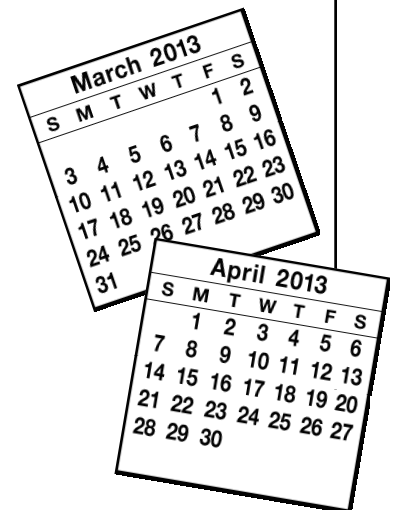
Pinochle
