The term ‘Advent’ originates from the Latin word, *Adventus*, meaning “Coming.” God is coming down to meet us in this special season. Advent is not a season of ‘passively’ waiting for Christ’s arrival, but it is an ‘exciting’ season where we prepare to meet our Messiah as he arrives in our time of need.

Last year, my parents traveled here from over five thousand miles from South Korea to see my baby, Jacob, when he was born on the day after Thanksgiving. I remember that we were ‘anxiously’ counting the months, weeks and days for their arrival because we were excited not only for my parents’ coming but also for the baby’s arrival in our life.




## Stockings for Loaves & Fishes




## Streets Closed for the California International Marathon Sunday, Dec. 4th

Every year, we choose one Sunday in Advent to collect an offering for payment of our Apportionments. Apportionments are funds that each United Methodist Church congregation gives for local, regional, national and international ministries including direct-service missions that reach out to people in need across the world like the Ethnic Minority, World Service, Black College and the Africa University fund as well as ministries that benefit our own local church like campus ministries and youth ministries. These funds are allocated or “apportioned” to each church on the basis of the church’s financial health.


On Sunday, December 18th, we will continue our tradition of lighting candles to symbolize the monies raised for the year.




## Preschool Parents' Night Out December 9th 5:30pm

## Sacramento Mabuhay Lion's Club "Got Socks?"





## From the Finance Corner

*“He brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey; and now I bring the firstfruits of the soil that you, LORD, have given me.” Place the basket before the LORD your God and bow down before him. Then you and the Levites and the foreigners residing among you shall rejoice in all the good things the LORD your God has given to you and your household. When you have finished setting aside a tenth of all your produce in the third year, the year of the tithe, you shall give it to the Levite, the foreigner, the fatherless and the widow, so that they may eat in your towns and be satisfied.*

Peace and Greetings in Jesus’ name! At this point in time, the budget is pretty well written, showing all of the potential expenses against all of the pledges and other income sources FOUMC will have available for the short budget year from January through June 2012. Unfortunately, expenses are winning out at the moment, meaning they are greater than the projected income. Back in October, the Finance Team began handing out pledge cards for the next six months. If you have not returned your pledge yet, please turn it in to the church office, or place it in the offering box, or give it to me. Currently, we’ve received about 45 pledges, and we usually receive over 65 each year. Pledges help the Finance Committee to project income more accurately and with a potential \$27,000 deficit going into next year, we need to track income as closely as we can.

By the time everyone gets this, the sanctuary will be all painted and pretty! Thanks to Sierra Construction for giving up the Thanksgiving week to make it happen! In addition to the donations that have already been made toward the painting of the sanctuary, this project was pre-funded by a loan from an anonymous donor. An agreement was made that all of the painting pledges for the sanctuary in the first six months of 2012 would repay the loan made by the donor. **Thanks to those of you that pledged to help paint the sanctuary, and thanks to our donor!** What better way to start the church year than with a freshly painted place to worship! My hope is that the painting of Spencer Hall will follow close behind, so the entire campus will be uniform in color.

The Trustees have not only worked on getting the painting put on the front burner, but they have been phenomenal in organizing work days, (and they have worked a lot on their own) to work on the beautification of the campus as a whole. They’ve cleaned up a lot of “stuff” in the LMS area of campus, and they’ve refurbished the lower parking lot wall to help keep dirt from sliding down onto the lower parking lot. Mostly, they have been at work finishing up the front wall on Fair Oaks Blvd, making room for the planting of new rose bushes and the placing of a sign that will show BEAUTIFULLY from either side of the Blvd that we are FOUMC, and we welcome EVERYONE to worship with us. OUR TRUSTEES ROCK! Thanks to all of you and to everyone who has donated so much time and energy to seeing these projects through! By early spring, our place will look amazing.

Lastly, I want to take a moment and thank **Megan Cambridge and Laurel Jensen** for answering questions at the Charge Conference in November. I was unable to make it to church that day, and it meant so much that the two of you stood in for me at the meeting! Thanks!!!

## 10th Anniversary Party for Music Director, Michael Schwagerus! January 6th at 6:30pm By Mary McCollum






