Last Sunday morning, we held a Congregational Meeting to consider recommendations from the Council's Parsonage Task Force. Following a presentation and time of discussion, the recommendations to purchase a senior minister parsonage (at 408 W Avery Street in Elmhurst) and sell one current parsonage were affirmed by the congregation. The Council will work to implement the recommendations passed by the congregation.

From the Council and Pastoral Search Committee: In January, the Pastoral Search Committee will be presenting a report and making a recommendation to Council to extend a call to Rev. Michael Laird to fill the Minister of Congregational Life staff position. Should the Council follow this recommendation, Council would bring it to a future Congregational meeting for the congregation's consideration. Please continue to enfold the process in prayer.

The Church Property Committee requests that since our own parking lot is so small, the able members of our congregation use the parking lots of Timothy Christian and the Seventh Day Adventist Church on Sundays. This is to provide adequate parking in the main lot immediately west of our church building for the visitors, elderly, and handicapped. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
