**On how we handle "change"....**After a strong summer of worship attendance, you'll recall that I was surprised last fall when our worship attendance hit a plateau. I told the staff at that time that I sensed that we were right on the brink of becoming "stuck" in a comfort zone as a congregation. Little did I know how much "change" would be on the way for FC! When the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost, it stirred up a lot of change for the early church. I suspect that not all of the disciples were thrilled about this. After all, they may have reached kind of a "comfort zone" as "The Twelve." Then suddenly, they had 3,000 newly baptized believers hanging around! *With two new pastors coming in this month, I would expect some changes.* I believe the Spirit is stirring in our midst, and that new ministries will likely unfold. Although, I may be one of those who might be "threatened" at times by the prospect of "change," *I hope that most of the time I might welcome the prospect of new vision, new insights, new ministries and find the courage and faith to say; "Let it be to us according to your will O Lord..."*

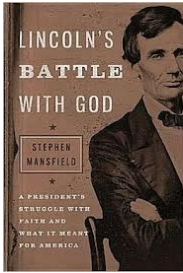

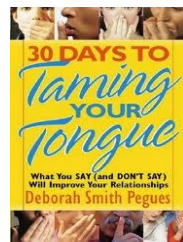

### **Lincoln's Battle with God: A President's Struggle with Faith and What It Meant for America**

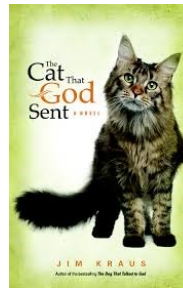

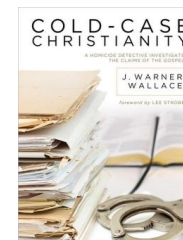
### **30 Days to Taming Your Tongue** by Deborah Smith Pegues

Pegues's 30-day devotional will help each reader not only tame their tongue but make it productive rather than destructive.



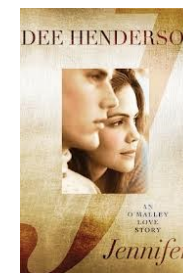
### **The Cat That God Sent** by Jim Kraus

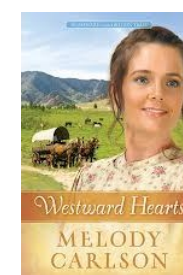
### **Cold-Case Christianity: A Homicide Detective Investigates the Claims of the Gospels** by J. Warner Wallace

### **Jennifer: An O'Malley Love Story** by Dee Henderson

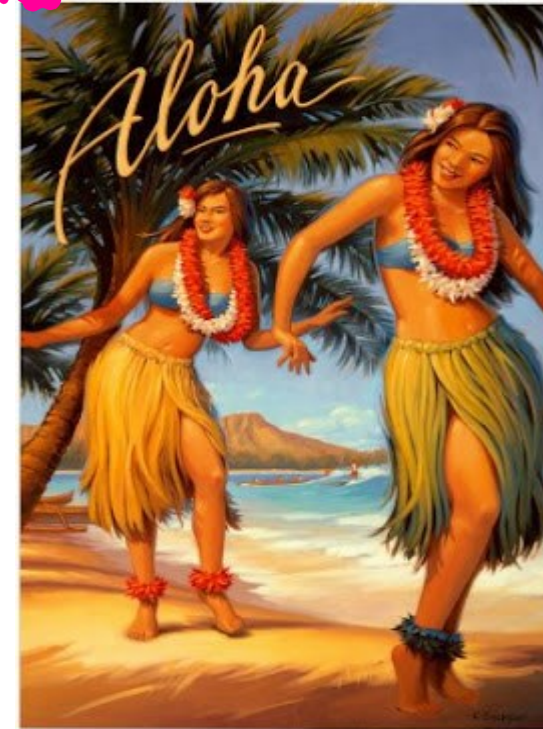

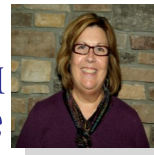
### GREETERS & WELCOME CENTER HELP NEEDED!
