If you can help, please get cards etc. to Tracy and we will get them to her. Thank you for caring for her!

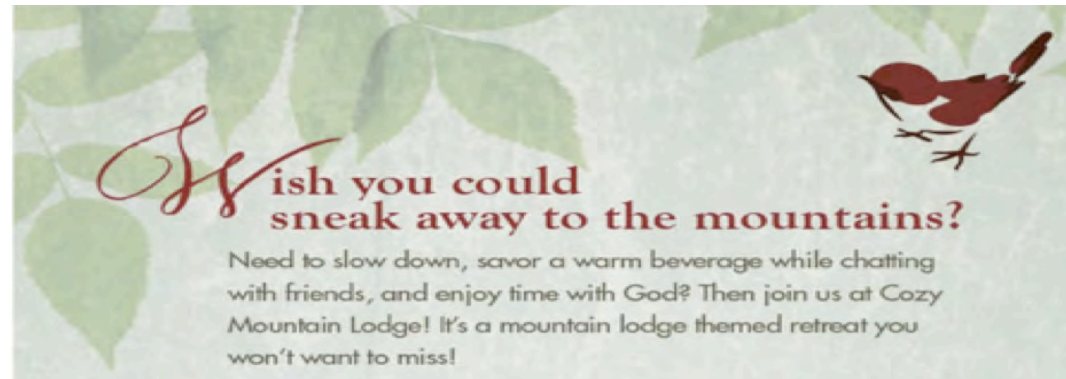
## Great Opportunities to Serve!
