Fees are non-refundable (in addition to regular summer tuition) & due at the time of registration.

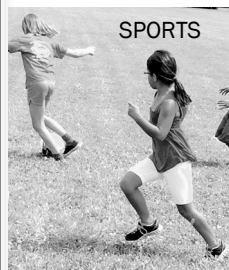
July 10th - 14th "In the Kitchen"
