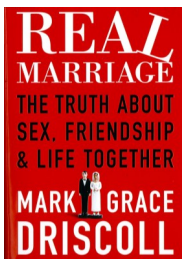
WEDNESDAYS: JANUARY 9—FEBRUARY 27, 6:30—8 PM
