

Church Ministries & Volunteer Opportunities

Nursery-

This is a safe environment for parents to leave their babies when they attend service or minister to others.

Wee-Ventures Island-

Children ages 2-3 are taught a lesson about Jesus and cared for during services.

Kiddie Kove-

Children age 4-Pre-K are taught a lesson about Jesus and cared for during services.

King's Kids-

King's Kids are broken in to two groups in our castle themed rooms, K-2nd grade and 3rd -5th grade. Our mission is to "help kids learn the word and build a relationship with Christ". We accomplish this through games and activities and by teaching children memory verses and Bible stories. We also offer several events for kids to bring their friends to. Some of these events include our annual Gong Show, Overnighter, Wet Wednesday and VBS.

Surge Uth-

Surge Uth is offered to students in 6th-8th grade. Their goal is to encourage Jr. High kids to trust God with their whole lives. Surge services run simultaneously with the adult services.

Collide-

This group meets on Wednesday & Sunday nights to minister to high school students in 9th-12th grade.

Collide Youth Band-

This team leads the youth into worship every Wednesday night.

Adult Praise Band-

This team ministers during every service. Their goal is to help people connect with God through the music they play.

Cleaning-

This team helps by cleaning the facility.

Transportation-

Our van driver picks up kids on Sunday mornings for church.

Premarital Counseling-

This ministry is required for all of those being married at FCC. With these 4-week sessions, couples are enlightened and better prepared for the commitment that lies ahead.

Nursing Home-

This is a group that ministers at local nursing homes.

Hospital Visitation-

This faithful group of people makes visits to the members of FCC who are patients at various hospitals in our area. As they pray for them, faith is released for a speedy recovery.

Path Center-

This is one of our outreach ministries that provide meals for the less fortunate.

Prayer Team-

The prayer team consists of several couples that minister to others through prayer. These couples are available to pray with those in need after most church services.

Lighting-

Lighting consists of setting the lights to create an inviting atmosphere. They operate the lights during each service.

Sound-

The sound ministry consists of running the soundboard and setting up the technical end of the stage. They also help out during special services along with our regular services.

Stage Manager-

This is one of those ministries that are behind the scenes. This ministry keeps everyone on the stage at the right times.

MIB (Men in Black)-

This takes place behind the stage; they help in setting up the stage during the service. They also provide security backstage.

Computer Operators-

The service computer operators help in supporting the teaching and praise & worship. They bring up the scriptures during each teaching and the words during praise & worship.

Camera Operators-

Video camera operator's video the services which are then aired throughout the week on various local channels. These services can also be viewed on the TVs in the foyer and in the Mother's Room.

Stage Decorating-

This group meets to change the stage decorating when needed. They also paint and build stage decorations.

Adult Drama-

This ministry meets most weeks on Monday nights for practice and prayer and to study acting techniques. Dramas are designed to enhance the teaching and connect people to the message. Anyone age 18 and up can attend a practice.

Greeters-

This team of couples is stationed at the front doors ready to greet people that attend our services. We want to make everyone feel welcome.

The Store-

The Store is open before and after each service. They carry a variety of books, DVDs, CDs, Christian T-shirts and Pastor Tim's teaching series.

Café-

The café is open before each church service and is an excellent place to grab a bite to eat and something to drink while enjoying great fellowship with others.

Lending Library-

Our lending library provides good Christian books for you to read. We have many new releases and are always updating our supply.

Meals for Moms-

This ministry provides meals for church members that have had a baby. If you enjoy cooking, this is a great opportunity to bless others.

Funeral Dinners-

For those that enjoy cooking and serving, this is a great ministry opportunity for you.
