I. Pastor Dustin Vorhis called the meeting to order

II. Church Clerk (Elise McElwain) read meeting minutes from 1st Quarter business meeting.

III. Pastor Dustin Vorhis presented the Income and Expense Report to the congregation (see attached)

1. Question from Steve Woodard about a \$2000 shortfall – answered by Church Treasurer (Courtney Daniels) that \$4,000 came from the building fund and the overall yearly average should come out fine.

V. King's Kids Director (Missy Himan) presented her report.

3. Special Activities
 - Dad and Dudes Nerf Night was a great event, a big success
 - Sunday school class incentives are still going on in the classes for children as they come, bring their bibles and say verses
 - Had meeting about camp with the kids
4. Special Training and Purchases
 - Background checks and Child Protection Training membership are on King's Kids workers will be going on
 - Purchased remaining Easter Carnival items needed
 - Most of VBS supplies bought

5. Communication and Outside-of-church Happenings
 - Regular emails to parents are continuing
 - Prayer for each child individually by name is continuing as well as prayer for all the teachers
 - Missy calls each child's parents with updates and about summer camp
 - Had a teacher's meeting at the beginning of the quarter
 - For children's church, rotating stations have been eliminated. Stephanie Vorhis teaches the pre-schoolers and Missy Himan teaches the school-age kids
 - The same curriculum is used during children's church as for Sunday school and is expanded upon
6. Teacher Training
 - A 90 minute online Child Protection Training will be taken by teachers this summer
7. Upcoming Activities
 - Young Adults "King's Kids Takeover" is taking place in July – class will give regular teachers a break during the whole month of July
 - VBS is July 12th – 16th a Sunday through Thursday
 - On Wednesday nights Kids will hand out fliers to the community and help with VBS setup and cleanup
 - Camp at Seneca Lake – parent meeting this-coming Sunday
 - Last week in July
 - Will be asking the church to send letter to the campers
 - August – Church picnic with games and prizes, date TBD

VI. WINGS Report – by Cheri Thacker, read by Elise McElwain

1. As reported last quarter, the Women In God's Service Ministry (WINGS) is still not having regularly scheduled meetings but they are on the go and serving all over our church and in surrounding areas.
2. Here are a few facts:
3. *The Women's Hospitality Committee, under Pam Fister's guidance served an awesome Easter Breakfast. We had an attendance of 125+.
4. *We have had approximately 5 funeral dinners in the last few months and under Betsy's guidance, women are always available with their cooking and "serving others" skills. It never ceases to amaze me that no matter how often they are called on...they always come through.
5. *Birthright held its Annual Baby Steps walk on May 30th and attendance was very good. A recent Birthright Baby Shower here at our church yielded several boxes full of baby items that were delivered to the Center by Delores Brooks to use in their newborn layettes that they hand out to brand new mothers.

6. *Emma Charles also held a 2 day garage/bake sale and made \$400 that was donated to the Birthright Center as a donation.
7. *Shirley Denning continues to crochet ground cover mats that are donated to a local homeless shelter. She is able to finish approximately 2 a month.
8. *Be in prayer as Amy Charles continues her Life Recovery Bible Studies and counseling to the women at Cross Roads. Our church partners with her to furnish bibles for these girls as she ministers to them.
9. *Several ladies traveled to Columbus last month for a Women of Faith Conference. It was a great time of Christian fellowship where our spiritual cups were over flowed with God's Word and messages for us.
10. Ladies are currently helping getting ready for VBS and if you look around, you can find the ladies of our church in ministries all over: Food Pantry, Choir, the Nursery, Downstairs teaching your children, running our Welcome Center, and ministering to others in outside areas, etc.
11. Future Tentative Plans are being discussed for a Ladies Banquet Event slated for possibly September, another Church movie night and our annual Fall Family Night in October.

VII. Youth Director, Steve Woodard gave his report.

VIII. Middle School Director, Randall Knaus gave his report.

1. Vision
 - Our vision for the Middle School Ministries, is for the kids to learn more of God and have a closer walk with Christ, in an environment they feel safe to talk and communicate to each other.
 - We also want to see relationships built that will last a lifetime, regardless if they move away from this area or not.
2. Average attendance – Sundays 8
3. 2nd Quarter Activities/Service
 - April- helped with Dean Drive landscaping project
 - Helped Betsy with funeral dinner setup and cleanup
 - 3 kids offered to share brief 3-5 minute devotionals during class

IX. Building Committee President, Randall Knaus, gave report on the New Building Addition

1. Hoped to be done by June – not happening
2. Latest inspection was disappointing – as issue with the firewalls came up
 - Issue has been resolved with a different type of drywall
 - Hopefully inspection will pass and be ready for insulation and drywall

X. Adult Education Director Joel Daniels Report (not present), read by Pastor Dustin Vorhis

1. All Sunday school teachers and back-ups have reviewed their ministry requirements, responsibilities and expectations. As part of hitting the reset button as it pertains to a greater level of accountability all teacher were asked to recommit to these ministry directives. Excitingly I received several positive comments about the opportunity to outwardly recommit to their leadership positions.

Since our last meeting the Adult Sunday school class teacher position is open. John has decided to step down. While the position remains open John has continued to teach and has committed to doing so as long as needed. My current plan for the new teacher will be to help get them up and running with a teacher development plan that will include observing two different Sunday school teachers teach a class and teach a minimum of two classes outside of their class. During this time they will be paired up with another teacher to be mentored and be given feedback by the mentor trainer and myself as they prepare to take on the new role.

A new class will be offered for continued education for our teachers in the next 6 weeks. The class will be focused on a cross pollination of teacher best practices designed to allow each teacher to share the best of what they do to prepare each week.

 - Transitional team committee was made up of youth volunteers, a youth parent, member at large, pastors and deacons
 - 1st youth director candidate declined the position –

 - They are still planning to resign by June 30th but will continue if required

 - Dustin has attended a 4 of 6 leadership conference meetings
 - Used copier purchased – bought at 25,000 copies
 - Future church survey – Dianna Deaton is working on it – will ask a variety of questions about personal preferences and needs but will not in any way trump scripture and is for informational purposes only
 - Daniel and Amanda Payne – we will be their sending church when they enter the mission field – an account is being set up for them to accept donations to their ministry
