SALVATION

I believe a person comes into a right relationship with God by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:8-9

Believe: Salvation Think

Key Idea:

I believe a person comes into a right relationship with God by God's grace through faith in Jesus Christ

Key Scripture:

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8-9

In today's culture, much like the time when this passage was written, there is a fundamental misunder-standing of God's grace towards mankind, especially, as it relates to salvation. In America, for example, there is a prevalent attitude that doing more gets you more. Or that doing good will give you more "good" into your life and that doing bad will bring more "bad" into your life. This attitude is what some call karma or "what goes around comes around". Many believe that if they have "good things" in life it is because they've somehow earned God's favor and blessings.

Grace can be defined as the love and mercy given to us by God because God wants us to have it, not because of anything we have done to earn it. Grace is central to our understanding of Christian faith and life. This love is most clearly demonstrated to us as humans through God's selfless giving of his son Jesus Christ to enable us to enter into a loving relationship with him. God calls us into a saving relationship with him through our faith.

Faith is a biblical word that refers both to the intellectual belief and to a relational trust or commitment. Biblical authors generally do not make a distinction between faith as belief and faith as trust, but tend to see true faith as consisting of both what is believed (e.g., that God exists, that Jesus is Lord) and the personal commitment to a person who is trustworthy and reliable. By putting our faith in Jesus, he brings us into a loving relationship with God our Father and through this relationship we become justified (a saving relationship).

No matter how hard we try, our good works alone will not get us to heaven so there is no way that we can boast – in other words, we can't do it alone! We need Jesus through the blood that he shed on the cross to bring us into that right relationship so that our sins are forgiven. It is through this relationship that good works naturally flow out; we want to do good things because of what Jesus has done for us. It is through the power of the Holy Spirit that we continue to do what needs to be done for others

God's grace is counter-cultural! It doesn't matter how good you are or how bad you've been. His grace is given to you and as a result you want to share that grace with those you meet. It is a gift that keeps on giving!

Life Application:

Remember that the next person you meet is worthy of God's grace just as you are. Even if that person has been unfriendly or caused you distress; God's grace was given to you and God's grace is also extended to them.

Prayer:

Father, your grace is sufficient. Help me to always remember that your grace extends to all that I meet and that I need to reflect your grace in my life to those I encounter. Help me draw others to you. Amen.
