


To Our Guests This Morning!

Think

Believe: The Bible

Key Idea:

I believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God that guides my beliefs and actions.

Key Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

I think we need to ask ourselves the following question: "Do we believe that the Bible is the inspired word of God?" Now this is a very interesting question; and probably one of the most important questions any Christian could ask themselves. What is so special, so unique about the Bible that Christians believe it is literally the inspired word of God?

In thinking about this question, we must consider the following:

First, the Bible is not just one single book. The Bible is actually a collection of 66 books. These 66 books contain a variety of genres: history, poetry, prophecy, wisdom literature, letters, and apocalyptic just to name a few. Some people refer to the Bible as a library since there are multiple books.

Second, the Bible was written by 40 different authors. These authors came from a variety of backgrounds: shepherds, fishermen, doctors, kings, prophets, and others. And most of these authors never knew one another personally.

Third, the Bible was written over a period of 1500 years. This collection of books shares a common storyline- the creation, fall, and redemption of God's people; a common theme- God's universal love for all of humanity; and a common message-salvation is available to all who come into a right relationship with God through faith in Jesus Christ.

Fourth, the 66 books of the Bible were written in 3 different languages. In the Bible we have books that were written in the ancient languages of Hebrew, Greek, and Aramaic; a reflection of the historical and cultural circumstances in which each of these books were written.

Think about the above realities: 66 books, written by at least 40 different authors, over 1500 years, and in 3 different languages. These books put together provide us with the Bible as we know it today. The fact that God reveals himself and His grand plan to us through the Bible should encourage us. The fact that many of the promises made within the Old Testament have been fulfilled should give us the hope that those made in the New Testament willibecom/have-been fulfilled.


Life Application:
