Believe: Humanity
Key Idea:

I believe all people are loved by God and need Jesus Christ as their Savior.

Key Scripture:

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

The question of whether God loves us – personally and individually – is common. Surrounded by the conditional love of humanity, we cannot easily comprehend that God would love us. We know our faults. We know that God is perfect and sinless. We know that we are not. Why would God, who is infinite and holy, love us, who are finite and sinful? And yet the great truth of the gospel is that He does! Time and again, Scripture reminds us of God’s love for us.

The Bible in reality is the love story between God and humans. From the creation to the cross God demonstrated his love to all people and he continues to do it today to each of us as well. Let’s take a look at some verses from the Old Testament that shows God’s love towards his chosen people, the Jews, through whom we can trace our heritage:

In your unfailing love you will lead the people you have redeemed. In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling. Exodus 15:13

...showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments. Exodus 20:6

Then the Lord came down in the cloud and stood there with him and proclaimed his name, the Lord. ⁶ And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, “The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, ⁷ maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Ex. 34:5-7a

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever. 1 Chronicles 16:34

For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Psalm 57:10

There are many more examples of God’s love towards us, but let us now move to the New Testament. Our key verse today, sums up God’s love towards us:

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

So the simple answer is, “yes.” Yes, God loves you! As hard as it may be to believe, it is the truth.

Life Application: I am loved by God!

Prayer: Precious Heavenly Father, it is hard sometimes to realize you have loved me more than I can ever love myself. Help me to recognize that love and then to love those you put in my path. Amen.
