**Believe: Worship** 

**Key Idea:** I worship God for who he is and what he has done for me.

**Key Scripture:** Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord;

let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before him with thanksgiving

and extol him with music and song. Psalm 95:1-2

Worship is the act of adoring and praising God or remembering that God is worthy as one who deserves homage and our acts of service. Worship is an individual act but worship is also an active part of the church community. Worship is an act done in private but also publically through prayer, through the psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs; through the reading of the Scriptures and through observance of baptism and communion. Worship can also be done through the arts such as dancing, singing, and poetry. Anything that we do can be an act of worship.

Worshiping God (praising God) no matter your circumstances is truly a gift. It might also be a call to be different or set apart in how you live and conduct yourself—that others may ask you why. We need to be bold in our faith and express our praise no matter what our circumstances may be.

So we praise by focusing on what God has done for us. We remember that God has been there no matter what we have faced or are currently facing. In sickness and in health, in joy or in sorrow, if we stumble or if we are dancing, God is there. There may be times when we don't know how to continue, but we move on because we know that God is there; so we continue to praise His Holy Name.

So we praise God by spending time with Him whether that be through prayer or reading His Word; a favorite passage of Scripture is a great way to reflect on all He has done for us. We praise God until we hear His quiet still voice speak to us. And then we praise Him all over again!

We praise God through song whether by ourselves or in community with others who are praising Him. We praise God with hearts full of joy, but we can also praise Him when our hearts are filled with sorrow due to the circumstances in the world. We know that God is in control even though we may not understand what is happening, but we praise God because we know He is there in the midst of all that is going on.

**Life Application:** We praise God no matter what our circumstances are because we know that God is with us.

**Prayer:** Father, you have shown your great love to us in so many ways, so we extend to you our praise. Accept our praise with our thankful hearts. But Lord, there are times in our lives that we find it difficult to praise you because we are focused on our needs; help us to remember all your mighty works in our lives so that we can praise you once again. It's in your Son's precious name we pray. Amen.
