Think Believe: Single-Mindedness

Key Idea: I focus on God and his priorities in my life.

Key Scripture: But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness.

and all these things will be given to you as well. Mt.6:33

What does it really mean to seek God's kingdom first? The NIV Application Commentary states "that his disciples are to make the kingdom of heaven the center of their continual, daily priorities. They have already entered the kingdom of heaven and are to live with that reality, drawing on God's ordering of their daily lives." The NIV Life Application Bible puts it as "to turn to God first for help, to fill your thoughts with his desires, to take his character for you pattern, and to serve and obey him in everything."

So seeking God's kingdom can be summarized in one word: **Prioritize**. His commandments, His desires. His love, should all be the center of what we are and desire to be. All other competing priorities in our lives will find their position as a result.

Jesus was pretty clear when He said to forsake all and follow Him. What He said then, He means now too. Even if that means doing things we're not comfortable with, pushing away anything that hinders our relationship with Him, or sacrificing the dreams we want most.

Our Father wants to give us blessing after blessing. He wants to open every window of Heaven and rain down gifts, both spiritual and natural, into our souls. He wants to fulfill the desires of our hearts. Sometimes we forget, however, that it is humble obedience and faith which bring Him on the scene.

Once we prioritize and really mean, "It's all about You, Lord" (in other words not what I want but want you want) we find a peace beyond belief. Our very souls find the rest that we have been searching for. But first we really need to put God first. Giving up and giving in is the hardest part. And it needs to be daily.

When you are overwhelmed by an ominous stack of work or when there is a challenge in a relationship, repeat this Scripture "But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." Then before doing anything else, clear your mind and give God a bit of your time. Pray, read another passage of Scripture, listen to some Christian music or listen to a sermon. Typically you find the peace (or rest) that was eluding you. You feel refreshed and able to better find a solution to that which was bothering you.

Let God be in the driver's seat. Let him take you where He wants you to be. He wants us to succeed, but He wants to prove that it is His strength in each of us, because we are nothing on our own.

Life Application: I need to prioritize and actively give God first place in my life.

Prayer: Father, help me to seek first Your kingdom and Your righteousness. Guide my heart and my thoughts and as a result everything else falls into place. I want to be the person you created me to be. Amen.
