I John 4:10-12

Believe: Love Think

Key Idea: I am committed to loving God and loving others.

Key Scripture: This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. ¹¹ Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. ¹² No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. 1 John 4:10-12

We are told over and over again in the Bible that we must love one another. But what does that mean? Let's look at a few passages and see how we can apply them today.

During the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told his followers, "But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." Our first response when someone is considered an enemy is to stay far away from them. This might be a former friend, a co-worker, or someone that is just confrontational. But Jesus asks us to pray for them. What I have discovered as I continue my walk to become Christ-like is that it is difficult to hate someone when you are praying for them. Oftentimes, God shows us that the things we find annoying about the other person are things that are in us.

Jesus also tells us in the book of Matthew that what we have done for others is important. Did we express the love of Jesus to someone who is less fortunate? There are some very practical ways that we can do that – serving at Hope Central, going on a mission trip (Ghana, for example), collecting supplies for Heaven's pantry, or donating food and clothes to Second Harvest or KARM. In many ways, cleaning out your closet can be a mission project in and of itself.

In the parable of the Good Samaritan, Jesus tells the expert in the law that our neighbor is anyone we meet. This might be the person on the street corner. I always find it challenging to discern whether God wants me to give something to a particular person, but rather than money there are other appropriate ways to offer assistance. You can give them a \$5 gift certificate to McDonalds or provide them with a nonperishable food item. Many of us are tempted to look the other way, but what if this person was put in your path so that you could be the Jesus they never knew.

The apostle Paul has similar words to us in the book of Romans. Paul tells us to bless those who persecute us; to rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn and live in harmony with one another. Further in the 12th Chapter of Romans, Paul tells us live at peace with everyone. This might mean stopping to chat with a co-worker who seems to be having a bad day. It might mean visiting a friend in the hospital or just listening to someone who has lost a loved one. This might also mean walking away from a potential argument so that peace reigns.

There are so many ways that we can share the love that was given to us. We need to remember that Jesus loves each of us the same. Each person we meet is a child of God.

Life Application:

I love others because God first loved me!

Prayer:

Jesus, you told us to love our neighbor as ourselves. Help me to reach out to those you put in my path, showing them love because you first loved me. Amen.
