Despite my circumstances,

John 15:11

Think Believe: Joy

Key Idea: Despite my circumstances, I feel inner contentment and understand my purpose in life. Key Scripture: "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." John 15:11

Kay Warren (the wife of Pastor Rick Warren) defines joy as "the settled assurance that God is in control of all the details of my life, the quiet confidence that ultimately everything is going to be alright, and the determined choice to praise God in every situation." So how can we have joy? Joy comes from knowing that God is in control.

We recently celebrated Easter, the highest point in the Christian calendar. We celebrate because we know that Jesus conquered death. Now, when you think about it, if Jesus conquered death, can he not help you with the challenges you face.

Joy is not about feeling happy. Joy is knowing that no matter what situation you are in, God is there with you helping you face the situation (both good and bad) and that ultimately everything will be alright because God is in control.

Now this is not a denial of the events that are going on in your life. Maybe you (or a loved one) has had a difficult diagnosis. Yes, there will be tears, yes there will be pain, but God is there beside you. He is holding you in the palm of his hand. Psalm 5:11 tells us:

But let all who take refuge in you be glad:

let them ever sing for joy.

Spread your protection over them,

that those who love your name may rejoice in you.

God's protection is over us. No matter what situation we are facing, God is with us and therefore we should be joy-filled.

Psalm 30:11 tells us a similar story:

You turned my wailing into dancing; you removed my sackcloth and clothed me with joy,

The sackcloth was a sign of mourning. With God at our side, we can embrace the life he is giving us and dance once again because he has clothed us in the radiant garments of joy.

One of the wonderful things about following Christ is that we know the end of the story. Jesus has defeated death, Jesus reigns supreme. Since we know the end of the story, we can focus on Jesus and know that everything will be all right. There may be bumps in the road right now, but in the end, all will be well. This is what gives us joy! God is in control.

Now, take a look at our key verse again. Jesus tells his disciples, "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." Jesus gives us his joy so that our joy may be complete. Another way to put this is that our joy will be full or that our joy may remain. So, ask Jesus for his joy so that you may have joy.

Life Application:

Joy comes from the assurance that God is in control.

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, keep me abiding in you so that your joy may be in me and that my joy may be full. Amen.
