PEACE

I am free from anxiety because
I have found peace with God,
peace with others and peace with myself.

Philippians 4:6-7

Believe: Peace Think

Key Idea: I am free from anxiety because I have found peace with God, peace with others, and peace with myself.

Key Scripture: Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7

What is the peace of God? We tend to think of peace as something fairly passive – not making waves, free from strife. But there is so much more that God wants us to experience.

The biblical concept of peace rests heavily on the Hebrew root *slm*, which means "to be complete" or "to be sound." We come to recognize this root word as "Shalom." The verb conveys the meaning "to be complete or whole" or "to live well." The noun had many nuances, but can be grouped into four categories:

Physical - wholeness of life or body (i.e., health);

Social - right relationship or harmony between two parties or people, often established by a covenant. If a covenant in the Old Testament was renewed or maintained often a "peace offering" was provided to show the commitment of the two people who made the covenant. This could also be or indicate the absence of war.

Financial - prosperity, success, or fulfillment; and Spiritual – right relationship with God.

Shalom was used in both greetings and farewells. It was meant to act as a blessing on the one to whom it was spoken: "May your life be filled with health, prosperity, and victory." As an adjective, it expressed completeness and safety.

Notice in the definition above that there is no anxiety. Shalom or peace is a good thing. If one is at peace, there is no way for anxiety to rear its ugly head.

But how can we get peace? God alone is the source of peace, for he is "Yahweh Shalom" (A name given to God by Gideon in the Old Testament when the Lord appeared to him in Judges 6). The Lord came to sinful humankind, historically first to the Jews and then to the Gentiles, desiring to enter into a relationship with them. He established with them a covenant of peace, which was sealed with his presence. Our best example of this is the blessing from Numbers 6:24-26:

The Lord bless you
and keep you;
the Lord make his face shine on you
and be gracious to you;
the Lord turn his face toward you
and give you peace."

So once we have a right relationship with God, then God's peace surrounds us and we can have peace with ourselves and with others. It must start with God and only God. May the Lord bless you and keep you, may his face shine upon you. May you feel His peace today and every day.

Life Application:

I have peace because I am in right relationship with God.

Prayer:

Father, I ask that your peace surround me. Help me to be where you want me to be. I crave your peace so that I can give that peace to those I encounter. Amen.
