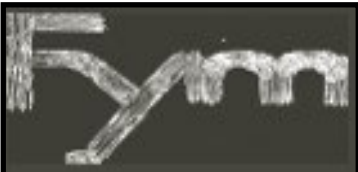
Committee Volunteers Needed— So much growth is happening we need several hearts and prayers working on the direction of Hope Central’s future.
