Merry Christmas to our Janitor

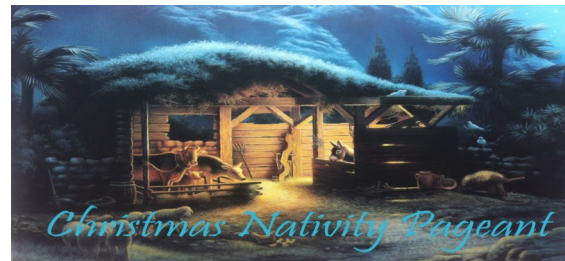
Gene McKissic does a wonderful job keeping our

be returned by today, Sunday, December 7th.

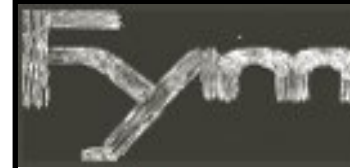


The Nativity Pageant Knoxville Civic Coliseum
