 - E. Jesus sought out Zaccheus.—v. 5
 - 1. God sought out Adam & Eve in the garden.
 - 2. Jesus sought the woman at the well--John 4.
 - 3. Jesus sought Levi the tax collector.
- III. Zaccheus was a changed man.—v. 7-9
 - A. Zaccheus received Jesus Joyfully.—v. 7 (II Cor. 5:17)
 - 1. He was a sinner now he is a sinner saved by grace.
 - 2. He was now compassionate—gave to the poor.
 - 3. He had a desire to make things right with others.
 - B. Zaccheus experienced the joy of the Lord.
 - 1. He received Jesus joyfully.—v. 6
 - 2. Jesus abode at his house.—v. 5
 - 3. Salvation was a reality.—v. 8
