Bus/Van Policies, Procedures and Rules

ONLY STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN OR OLDER ARE ALLOWED TO RIDE
THE BUS

Students should be made aware that riding the church bus is a privilege. Parents, please explain to your children the importance of good behavior on the bus.

Ferguson Avenue Baptist Church has determined that the bus service will be provided and that students will be picked up at their homes and they should be ready to enter the bus promptly when it arrives.

The following are rules for appropriate behavior on the bus:

- Obey the bus driver and all adult supervisors.
- Do not distract the bus driver.
- Students must wear their seat belts at all times.
- Keep hands, arms, feet, legs and head inside the vehicle. Keep hands and feet to yourself and not in aisles.
- Talk quietly and use good language at all times.
- Cursing, swearing or loud talking is not allowed.
- No eating, drinking or chewing gum.
- No littering.
- No cell phones or video games are allowed.
- No tampering with bus controls, emergency exists or bus equipment.
- Fighting, horseplay, hitting, pinching or teasing is prohibited.
- Students will be dropped off at the home where they were picked up unless we have permission, *in writing*, from parent/guardian to do so.
- If necessary to maintain orderly conduct on the bus, assigned seating may be established.

Again, bus transportation is a privilege extended only to students who display good conduct. Suspensions may be made for one, two, three or four weeks. After continued disorderly conduct, refusal to obey the driver and/or repeated suspensions, a student may be denied transportation.
