#### **WHAT'S NEW**

### From Eure Pastor's Desk By John D. Eure

Occasionally, I enjoy posting articles from **Thom Rainer**, president of Lifeway Christian Resources (formerly the Sunday School Board). In his August 31st blog, he wrote about the <u>Seven Internal Barriers to Growth in a Church</u>. In last month's article, I wrote about the importance of self-reflection in congregations. After reading this abbreviated article, let's continue working towards pleasing Christ which requires faith for effective change.

There is rarely a simple explanation for the decline of a church. It is often a complex mix of cultural, theological, attitudinal, and internal issues. In this article, I address the latter issue.

Internal barriers refer to those obstacles that are inherent in the organization and the facilities of the church. They are also called structural barriers. Stated simply, these barriers are self-imposed or self-inflicted.

Some of these barriers are long-standing and difficult to remove. Others, such as a redesigned website, can be accomplished with little pain. Let's look at the six most common internal barriers in churches.

- 1. Facility Barriers. The two most common are poor signage and inadequate parking. Other common facility barriers include dirty and cluttered facilities, inadequate worship space, inadequate children's space, and poor sound and lighting in the worship space.
- 2. Governance Barriers. These barriers include restrictive bylaws and policies, a model of church government that is not working as intended, and frequent acrimonious business meetings.
- 3. Staffing Barriers. Churches often staff the way they've always done it. But times change and needs change. Staffing alignment and job descriptions of the 1990s may be inadequate today. If a church leader is not in a position that matches his or her gifts, abilities, and passions, the church has a structural growth barrier.
- **4. Cultural Barriers.** These barriers refer largely to attitudes and practices of the leadership and membership as perceived by guests.
- **5. Church Calendar**. One activity is stacked upon another. The church is so busy doing good things that it neglects the best things... the most often neglected ministries in busy churches are evangelism and ministry beyond the walls of the church.
- 6. **Worship Times.** Many church leaders have not asked what are the most conducive times to reach the community. Frankly, the traditional 11:00 am worship time as a single offering makes little sense today.
- 7. Website Barriers. One of the simplest internal or structural changes a church can make to reach more people is to update the website. The website is the front door for guests.
