

SCHOOL UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

As a part of the commitment to training our students to be prepared for life, FBCS has established a Uniform Dress Code. Parents and students please note that when you sign the application to attend FBCS, you agree to comply with First Baptist Christian School's Uniform and Dress Code.

FBCS School Uniforms, (pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, jumpers, polos, blouses, turtlenecks), can be purchased from Lodi Uniform or the School Uniform Department at any retail store. FBCS "Plaid" is only available at Lodi Uniform.

Uniform Colors are Navy or Khaki Pants, skirts, skorts, or shorts. School plaid is available from Lodi Uniform for skorts, skirts and jumpers. White Peter Pan Blouses may be worn with jumpers and skirts. Polo shirts colors are navy blue, light blue, heather gray, hunter green, white, or yellow. Polo shirts must be of one solid uniform color.

General Style: All clothes should be clean and neat, containing no holes, graffiti, or inappropriate words, logos, temporary tattoos, or body markings of any kind. Cargo pants/shorts are not acceptable as school uniform.

Jewelry/Hats

Boys: No earrings, body piercing, or distracting jewelry is to be worn on campus or at school activities. No pocket chains, neck or wrist chains other than standard jewelry. Knit type hats may be worn outside for warmth. All other caps or hats are not to be worn at school. No tattoos.

Girls: No more than 2 earrings per ear. No dangling earrings over ¼" long. No body piercing except for the ears. No pocket chains, neck or wrist chains other than standard jewelry. Knit type hats may be worn outside for warmth. All other caps or hats are not to be worn at school. No tattoos.

Grooming

Boys: Hair must be neatly groomed. Any dramatic hair coloration or extreme cuts of hair are not acceptable. The length of the back of the hair is not to exceed the middle of a standard dress shirt collar and may not be longer than the top of the eyebrows in front. Mohawks, braids, pony tails, duck tails, or pattern cuts are not permitted. **Shirts must be tucked in and boys in fourth grade and above must wear a belt. Belts must be navy, black or brown.**

Girls: Hair must be neatly groomed. Any dramatic hair coloration or extreme cuts of hair are not acceptable. Makeup is not allowed for girls in grades K-6. Girls in grades 7-8 may wear makeup, if applied discretionally. **Shirts must be tucked in and girls in fourth grade and above must wear a belt if clothing has belt loops. Belts must be navy, black or brown.**

Shoes and Socks

Athletic style shoes are recommended for school – no cartoon characters, musical, or light up shoes. All shoes must have closed toes and heels and must either lace-up, buckle or Velcro. Leggings and tights (in school colors) are permitted only under school skirts and shorts. Leggings with lace or trim on the legs are not to be worn. Socks are required and must be a solid "uniform" color. Socks are not to be below the top of the shoes. **No** boots (including Uggs) are acceptable.

Friday Dress

Students may wear jeans, denim shorts (knee length), or denim capris. The jeans must be appropriate for school; **no jeggings, holes, baggy, or tight fitting (skinny) jeans. No denim skirts.** Uniform shirts and school logo t-shirts are acceptable. **No other tops will be acceptable.**

Students may wear non-uniform socks on Fridays so long as they reflect the biblical standards to which we hold.
