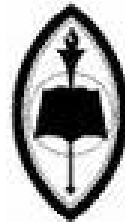

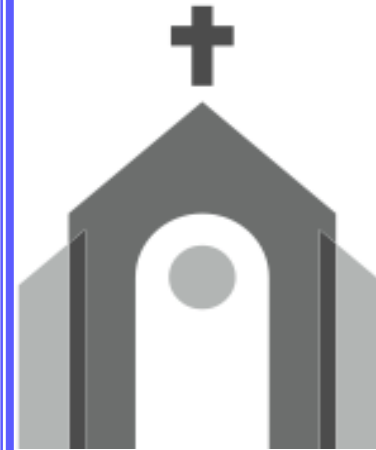

From the Pastor

I just recently spoke at a youth camp for a few days down in Norman Park. It was an amazing time hanging out with all the different youth groups and seeing the various competitions, games, bible studies, and excitement during worship. I always appreciate the opportunities to speak at various things like that. However, this speaking engagement was different than any of the other ones I have ever done. Not because of worship or the facilities or the camp theme or any of those type of things. It was different because this time I had someone very special to me go with me.....Asher! As the camp speaker I was a little reluctant about bringing Asher with me at first. Would he be able to be quiet while I preached? Would he be able to keep up with the pace and flow of the busyness of the camp schedule? Would he be able to play as the only kid who wasn't a teenager? Well to my relief, Asher did amazing. I was so proud of his overall flexibility with the schedule and with his obedience and involvement during his time there. But one of the things I am most proud of, is that he learned to ride his bike while at camp. During our free time, he and I practiced his balance and his pedaling as I held on to his seat until finally, I let go. And once I let go, he did it all by himself. Before the day was over, he was able get going by himself and ride for half an hour without falling.

As I think about that day, there are a few things that stick out to me about Asher's bike riding success. Before he was able to ride, he needed to know that I believed he could do it. He had to trust that I would not let go of him until he was ready. He had to believe that being able to ride a bike was better than not being able to, even if it means falling every now and then.

As I think about that, I wonder how often we miss out on what our loving Heavenly Father has for us because we lack trust in Him. You see, Asher's success was based upon his belief that I knew what I was doing as well as his belief in what I said he could do. The same is true in our relationship with God. Do you trust in His character? Do you believe His word? God is a good Father and He has a good purpose for you, even if you fall some along the way.
