We need our men to help us hand out door hangers to the neighborhoods in the north side of town. We figure there are about 320 homes to reach. Please help us with this outreach.





Do you ever think about light versus darkness? Light changes everything, right? Walk into a dark room, and you can't see anything. But that all changes when you turn on the lights. Before, you had no direction on where to go. Now, you can see where to walk or you can see to do what you need to do. Bringing light into a dark space is like bringing life into that space. You see a lot of illustrations throughout the Bible about living in the light versus living in darkness. We see in 1 John 1:5-7 that "...God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all...if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin." Prior to Christ's redemptive work in our lives, we were in darkness. However, life in Christ means that we are now in the **light**.
