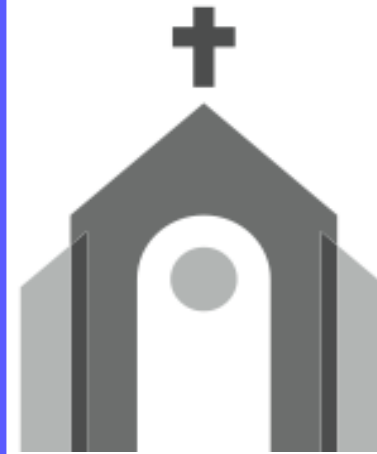

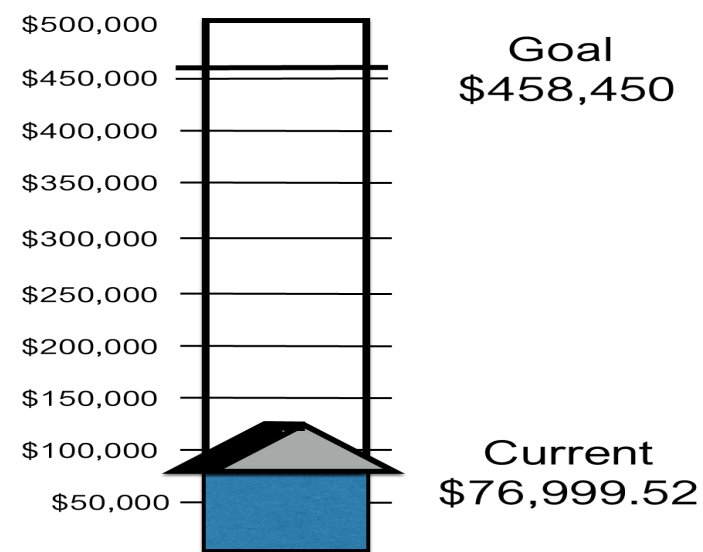

The Old Testament is very fascinating to me, and I love to see how God worked in different situations. It is interesting to see how certain people obeyed and trusted in God and how He worked as a result of their obedience. Currently, I am reading through Exodus about Moses and Pharaoh. Here, you get two sides of our responses to God. Moses is seen doing just as God commands. You see plague after plague that God brings about to Pharaoh and the Egyptians through Moses. It is incredible to reflect on the power and the move of God as Moses is obedient to God. On the contrary, you see Pharaoh continually hardening his heart against the Lord and refusing to let the Israelites go free. If you stop and place yourself in these different situations, imagine the effect of a polluted water source, numerous frogs, overwhelming gnats (I guess we already have some of that in GA), plagued livestock, and heavy hail that would destroy livestock, plants, and trees. The 10 plagues would have shown the amazing power and work of God, *yet* Pharaoh continued to harden his heart. The question for me is, "How do I daily respond to the Lord?" Is the Lord trying to do something good in my life but I resist His work and power? Are you and I obeying the Lord as He is speaking and leading? When we walk in obedience and in faith, we experience a beautiful life with the living God, and we can experience His power at work in us and through us. Let us not harden our hearts to him today.

It is hard to believe it is February! We are getting set to host the **Spaghetti Lunch Fundraiser** for the students on February 3rd right after the worship service. As we look to Student Life Camp in the summer and other events, we are so grateful for your investment in the lives of the students so the gospel may go forth and that their lives will be changed forever!
