WMU—Current Missions

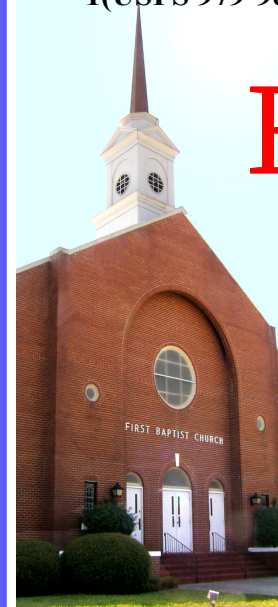

From the Pastor

Dear FBC Faith Family,

Sometimes I wonder if we take enough time to reflect. The other day I was spending time with a friend that I have known almost all my life.
