Sunday Night Blitz

Our youth traveled to Southern Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky for M-Fuge Camp in the middle of June. This year's camp was smaller in size (number of people there) but this allowed the Fuge staff to have a greater impact on our kids. We were blessed to hear the report from camp that the youth gave on June 24th.
