- 1) I am a member/associate member or am pursuing membership at First Baptist Church.

- 3) As proper for a leader, I do not want to give “cause for offense in anything, in order that the ministry be not discredited” (2 Cor. 6:3; Rom. 14:13-19), therefore, I will ask myself the following questions when considering an activity and seek to modify my behavior accordingly:

 - Would it cause confusion, disillusionment, or disharmony with students, families, or with the other leaders?
