### A NOTE FROM PASTOR TROY



As Resurrection Sunday approaches, I hope you will take some time to reflect upon all that God has done for you. Before we get there, we go through Maundy Thursday and Good Friday (April 2 & 3). These two days hold great significance for us as Christians. Maundy Thursday we commemorate the

Our goal through prayer support is to cover every day in the month of April with prayer for Ekklesia. We want to do this with multiple people each day. In addition, on April 26, we will take a one-time love offering for Ekklesia. I hope that you will begin to seek the Lord concerning the ways you can support this great work.

Please be in prayer for our church as we move forward. As David moves into retirement, he leaves behind big shoes to fill. I have counted it a privilege to serve with a man with a heart for the Lord and a heart for teaching people God's word. I look forward to seeing how God is going to use David in the years to come.
