Thoughts from Our Youth Pastor...

Fall is here and everything is in full swing. One of my favorite things about fall is football season. It doesn't get me amped like basketball does, but after 162 games of baseball I am ready for something a little more action packed. I think about football and my favorite part about it is the long pass. I just love it. My least favorite part about football is the huddles. There is just something about a bunch of guys in tight pants with their arms around each other that just does not excite me, but it is important. It is when the coach calls the play and it is communicated with the rest of the players, but we must keep sight of the fact the huddle is not the game, it is not the main point, or where all the action is. What would happen if you turned on the game and you watched your team huddle up and then run to the sideline? At first, you would probably think you missed something; maybe a time out or an injury, but what if they kept doing that over and over again? You would say that is pretty stupid or lame. I believe to a lot of people this is what the church in America looks like. We huddle up and the pastor calls a play from the playbook (Bible), and we get all excited but instead of running the play we all go home and look forward to huddling again. The world is waiting for us to do something besides huddle. We make a lot of noise and get real excited about the play in the huddle, but many times we fumble before the play even begins. The Bible says we are to be in the world but not of the world. Even though this isn't a game there are still things to be won or lost. Souls are at stake and while we are huddling people are dying without Christ. That is why the world is frustrated and confused with the church. If we believe the Bible and what Jesus said, then why don't we have a sense of urgency in running the play. We were not meant to be spectators in this spiritual battle; we were designed and called to participate. It is time to get involved and engage in the battle. We were meant to be more than a monastery. It is time for the people of God to become relevant in today's culture. We need to huddle, but we must remember that is not the main point. We must execute the plays and plan God has for us.
