

What's up in June?

6 attributes of God we all need to know... Many people base their understanding of God on their own perceptions of what a god should be. I think God is.... What we think is not important; what matters is what God says about Himself and our response to it. God has reveled Himself through Scripture. In our current study – Beyond Belief: Exploring the Character of God – we will examine six attributes of God that lead us to living fruitful lives in right relationship with Him.
