You are so willing to serve and love on kids in any way, shape, or form and that is rare, even in a church. So thank you. I have learned so much from so many of you. Thanks for letting me be a part of the FBC Natchez community. I feel incredibly blessed. I love ya'll and it was not an easy decision but one that needed to be made.
