A friend here told me once "The Lord is good, His plans

health problems. I had a spinal cord injury 7 years ago and  
still have chronic effects from that injury. I thought I would  
be able to do this job well and be able to take care of my  
physical health at the same time, but I have realized that  
that is not the case. So as much as I wish it was different, I  
resigned last Monday and my last day will be on the 14th.

I know I haven't been here long at all, but I already love  
all of you and your children (that only took one day). I will  
miss their stories, smiles, tenacity, creativity, sweet prayers,  
and questions. They have changed my life and the way I  
see things. Y'all have raised incredible children. I think they  
are some of the best, not that I am biased or anything.  
There are not enough words to express what these children  
mean to me: thank you for sharing them with me.

Thank you for loving me, taking me in with open arms,  
and sharing your lives with me. I tell people all of the time,  
"You wouldn't believe how generous and gracious these  
people are." I mean it. You are so willing to serve and love  
on kids in any way, shape, or form and that is rare, even in  
a church. So thank you. I have learned so much from so  
many of you. Thanks for letting me be a part of the FBC  
Natchez community. I feel incredibly blessed. I love ya'll and  
it was not an easy decision but one that needed to be made.
