SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The members of First Baptist Church of Dover desire that all students be able to participate in ministry activities, regardless of financial constraints. Full and partial scholarships are awarded based on availability of funds, request of participants, and fulfillment of scholarship requirements. Scholarship funds are gladly, yet sacrificially, donated by church members. With this in mind, in order to be good stewards of the monies entrusted to scholarship funds, the following scholarship requirements have been set up. *The idea is not to create hurdles, but to instill ownership on behalf of those who receive scholarships and ensure the responsible use of those funds.*

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Minister to Students and after the applicant performs a sufficient quantity of church-approved volunteer work, the amount of which will be determined based on requested amount of scholarship funds.
- Students who receive scholarship funds are required to attend the event for which they are awarded a scholarship.
- If a student becomes ill or has a family matter which will prevent him/her from attending the event he/she has been awarded a scholarship for, the parent/guardian must notify the Minister to Students immediately. The Minister of Students will then determine whether or not the absence is approved. Absences due to work, sporting events, or preventable scheduling conflicts will not be excused.
- As many event fees are non-refundable, when a scholarshiped student fails to attend the event he/she received funds for, those funds are wasted. This irresponsibility undermines the ability to raise additional scholarship funds for future events and may prevent other students from going, who would have been able, had the wasted funds been awarded to them. Students who fail to attend, for any reason not approved by the Minister to Students, will not be granted any further scholarship funds for future events until the wasted scholarship funds have been repaid. Appeals may be directed to the Minister of Outreach and Administration.
