



July 30 – Aug. 2, 2017

Kidz Kamp is held at Bogg Springs Baptist Camp. It is located in Arkansas, near Wicks which is 25 miles south of Mena and right along the AR/Oklahoma state line.

We will need to leave for camp ASAS right after the Sunday morning service (12:30 deadline). Campers will need to bring a lunch and a drink with a screw-on lid, to eat in the church van, once we are on the way. We will put lunches in the gym refrigerators. Put your child's name on their lunch (in throw-away containers).

What To Bring

Bible (not electronic) - Pen/pencil – notebook - \$ for snacks/souvenirs (see page 2)
Sleeping bag/bedroll – pillow – towels – laundry bag – Toothbrush – deodorant – soap – shampoo – Clothing for worship services (shorts are OK) – etc.

Recreational Clothing: All campers will be involved in a recreation each day and will need to dress with play clothes and sturdy shoes that can and will get wet and maybe muddy. Because part of the games each day will be in the pool or in water, wear a swimsuit under your play clothes and the girls need to wear dark color T-shirts for modesty. (Girls, a dark T-shirt also includes the pool free-time swimming.) At no time will your child need to dress up.

PLEASE MARK YOUR CHILD'S NAME on all items and clothes you want your child to bring back home. It would also be helpful to put a large name tag on each bag/suitcase.

What NOT To Bring

iPad/iPod/CD/Tablets players/e-book Readers – No ear pods – Electronic games of any kind
No DVD/TV/Radio players of any kind. No novels/reading books. No Shaving cream (for play).
Fireworks, weapons, tobacco products (or anything else that might result in a call to parents)

ALL medications (including aspirin, etc.) with complete instructions must be turned in to your child's adult sponsors before leaving the church. Homesick kids are the parent's responsibility to bring home. Rides from camp will only be provided in case of accident, illness, or emergency. Parents will be notified of any of these. Emergency calls from home only! (870-385-2443) Campers may bring a cell phone but the adult sponsor may need to regulate it's use.

Even though this is a Christian Camp, we are asking that all money be kept by the adult sponsor your child is assigned to. Please put spending money in a **sturdy envelope** with your child's name on it (do not write on the envelope the amount inside). Only put **\$5 & \$1 bills** in that envelope. The child can get needed amounts each day from their adult sponsor. There is a snack shop, drink machines (that take crisp \$1 bills) & a small gift shop. *[Don't forget the McDonalds lunch envelope.]*

Be sure to look VERY CAREFULLY over the lists under "What to Bring" and "What NOT to Bring." You will want to have everything you need including important medication that adult sponsors will help you with.

Everyone needs to be at the church with everything you need. **We will load up the luggage at 9:00 AM on Sunday, July 30th. Leave before 12:30 PM**
PACK A LUNCH: Kids will eat a lunch parents pack for them to eat in the van on the way to camp. Please send a **drink with a screw-on lid.**

We plan to return to the church:

Wednesday, Aug. 2nd, at about 4:30 PM
Please send a separate sealed envelope with Lunch money for Wednesday with your child's name on it. The adult sponsors will safely hold the money until we arrive at McDonalds on the way home.
