

Quizzing Objectives

1. To proclaim God's wonderful grace and salvation through Bible quiz questions. Parents and friends may then see their need of becoming a Christian and be challenged to accept Christ as Savior.
2. To promote and encourage young people in Bible memorization and review of their Awana handbooks.
3. To provide a competitive atmosphere in which quizzers can display their Bible knowledge and gain a sense of accomplishment.
4. To give young people a greater love for - and working knowledge of - the Bible.
5. To build quiz leader-quizzer relationships.

Quiz Format Overview (See Page 7 for full details)

T&T Awana Bible Quizzing in Arkansas incorporates the following two formats with quizzers answering the questions individually.

Multiple-choice Quizzing

The multiple-choice segment allows quizzers to perform in a low-key competitive atmosphere. Quizzers from each book are given an opportunity to answer all 12 multiple-choice questions from their handbook using A, B & C labeled paddles to indicate their choice of the correct answer.

Speed Quizzing

In the speed quizzing segment, clubbers from each book compete against other teams in the same book. There are 12 questions per book. All teams will be read the quiz question. The first person to respond is allowed to answer the question. *If the first person answers incorrectly the second person to respond is allowed to answer for half point value.*

Scores are totaled for individuals and for a combined total of all the quizzers on the same team. Individual ribbons and team plaques are awarded accordingly (see Awards).

Organization Overview

The organization of the regional Bible Quiz meets depends on the number of churches and teams participating. A team refers to the quizzers in each handbook. **A team consists of one to three members. Two quizzers from each team may compete at one time in Multiple-Choice and in Speed quizzing.**

New 5th & 6th Grade Handbook (Year A: 5th & 6th grades) **Start Zone & sections 1.1 – 2.8**

Registration

1. An official Bible Quiz meet must include a minimum of three churches. Teams must register with the Specialist. He will provide you with the forms and information.
2. Early registration could guarantee participation in situations when many churches register. Teams are accepted on a "first-paid" basis.
3. A church may enter one or two teams per book based on availability. A third team for the same book may be registered IF there are more than 6 teams registered for that book at the same quiz.

4. The church may register teams for any or all books but is not required to enter for all books.
5. The registration fee is set by the Awana quiz meet specialist to help defray quiz expenses.
6. Each church must provide at least two workers who are acquainted with the quiz rules.

General Information

Apparel

1. Awana emphasizes the importance of modesty, neatness and cleanliness in the apparel worn by both leaders and clubbers of all ages.
2. All quizzers, coaches, workers and leaders must wear an official Awana uniform.

Appeals

1. Only the official coach may appeal a question or an answer. The coach does this by calling out “**question.**” The immediate preceding question is the only one that may be appealed by the coach.
2. All appeals are directed to the head judge. When recognized, the coach confers privately with the head judge. After the coach voices the question, the coach must return to his or her seat while a decision is being made.
3. The head judge may consult with quiz judges before making a decision. In all cases, the decision of the head judge is final.

Audience Information

1. Help from the audience counts as a wrong answer, even if the answer is correct.
2. Cheering and applauding are encouraged after the quiz master gives the correct answer in Multiple Choice quizzing and the head judge gives the ruling in the Speed quizzing. Informality helps relax quizzers and motivates them as they compete.

Awards

Bible Quiz awards will be given to all the quizzers and their one (1) Coach per team.

Team Awards

- 1st Place:** Neck medallions & church plaque
2nd, 3rd & 4th Places: Ribbons

Individual Awards

High Honor ribbon: 3 correct Speed Questions
or 12 correct Multiple Choice Questions

Quiz Champion ribbon: 3 correct Speed and 12 correct Multiple Choice questions

Participation patch: For every quizzer on the roster sheet..

Check-in Paperwork Required

1. Teams are to be checked in by their coach at the time stated by the event specialist.
2. Coaches will submit any corrections in the names of their quizzers on the quiz roster sheet that was sent to the event specialist seven (7) days before the date of the quiz meet.
3. **Awana Clubs Parental Consent and Release of Liability form must be turned in for each participant. These forms will be sent to Awana Clubs International for retention. Local church forms are encouraged for the benefit of the local church, but may not be substituted.**

Coaches

1. Each team is allowed only one official coach during the quiz meet.
2. Coaches are to know where the quizzers are and need to be at all times.
3. The team coaches may talk to their teams while the teams rotate for their quiz or during team substitutions. Each coach may sit on the front row while their team is quizzing.

Points – Total scores from all segments are added together to determine the winning teams.

Recording of the Questions is Not Permitted - No recording of questions is allowed. No writing them down, no video recording of them. Videotaping is only allowed the first five minutes and then the announcement will be made to turn off all video equipment.

Quizzing Out – In speed quizzing, when a quizzer answers three questions right or answers two questions wrong, they can no longer answer questions. As soon as three speed questions are answered correctly, a bonus 20 points are awarded and the quizzer gets a High Honor ribbon. As soon as two speed questions are answered incorrectly, the quizzer is to put down their quiz button, not answering any more questions. The score keeper will notify the Quiz Master when a quizzer quizzes out. In either case, a substitute may replace the quizzer right away. (see “Substitutes” rules below)

Quiz Questions & Answers

1a. From the New Handbooks, questions will be asked from the Start Zone & handbook sections 1.1 through 2.8 under MEMORIZE, Word Definitions, the blue opening paragraph in EXPORE, START HERE and EXPLORE Questions. (Explorer answers are taken from the Small Group Guide other than “Answers will vary.”) Quizzing will not include information from the Silver or Gold pages, any Q&A with “Answers will vary,” Story Line, Fun Facts, Optional (or Bonus) Boxes, etc.

1b. Challenge Questions will be asked only on what is required in each section to pass the section. Each section has a list of what is required. Quizzers are not expected to know silver or gold sections. (See page 4 “Overview” for which sections questions will come from.)

2. Quizzers must quiz in the book they are currently passing sections in.
3. All questions will be taken from the material in the latest edition of the Awana handbooks.
4. AUTHORIZED BIBLE VERSIONS ARE: KJV, NKJV, NIV 1984 & ESV. ANSWERS MAY COME FROM ANY VERSION, QUOTES MUST BE FROM KJV, NKJV, NIV 1984 or ESV, AND YOUR ENTIRE ANSWER MUST COME FROM ONE OF THOSE VERSIONS AS USED IN THE HANDBOOKS.
5. T&T Quizzers will be asked 12 multiple-choice questions & 12 Speed questions from each handbook. See “Organization Overview” for which parts of the handbooks are quizzed on. Also see “Types of Questions” on the last page for more details.

Substitutes

1. Substitutes must be passing sections in the same book as the one for whom they are substituted and must be on the same team roster sheet.
- 2. Clubbers who have quizzed out may not return as a substitute (even at the halfway point).**
3. Substitutions may be made at the ¹halfway point of the multiple-choice round, ²between the multiple-choice round and speed quiz round, or at the ³halfway point in the speed round.
4. Substitutions will also be permitted ⁴when a quizzer quizzes out during the speed round (three right answers or two wrong answers).

Study of Handbooks, Bibles, etc. - Once the Bible quizzing has begun no further studying of handbooks, Bibles or other materials are allowed.

Team - Each clubber must quiz from the handbook they are currently passing sections in. No clubber may quiz in the same book for two years.

Time-outs - The quizmaster is the only official who can declare a time-out.

Tie Score - In the event of a tie for first place, teams are given a **two-minute** speed round to break the tie.

Note: Only 5 points are awarded to the one team's total score that wins the tie. Answering tie breaking questions do not count toward earning the Honor nor Champion Ribbon.

Suggested Bible Quiz Schedule:

- Welcome – Flag Ceremony
- Message
- Recognition of teams
- Explanation of procedures\
- Quizzing by Handbooks in this order: Start with quizzers from the new 5th & 6th grade All-Together Method handbook and finishing with teams competing from Mission: Evidence of Grace.

Procedure Rules of T&T Quizzing

Individual Multiple-Choice Quizzing

1. One or two quizzers per team, from each book, may compete at one time in Multiple Choice Quizzing.
2. Quizzers start by holding the stacked paddles together, flat on their laps, with the handles next to their stomachs. They also hold the main part of the stacked paddles with a hand on each side (hands completely away from the paddle handles).
3. The quizmaster prefaces each question with the word “**question.**” No talking is allowed by the audience, coaches or quizzers from the word “**question**” until after the answer is given.
4. Questions and three possible answers for each question will be read once. (The quizmaster may occasionally read a question and/or three answers twice if the quizmaster deems it necessary.) Should the quizmaster read a question improperly, the question may be discarded and a new one selected.
5. During the reading of the questions, quizzers must only look down at their paddles while mentally deciding their answers. Looking any other place is an automatic disqualification from that question.
6. When all answers have been given, the quizmaster will say, “**Think about your answer.**” During this five-second-thinking time, quizzers mentally select the answer they believe to be correct. Again, keeping their hands completely away from the paddle handles.
7. Then, when the five seconds are up, the quizmaster will call, “**Paddles up.**” At the call “**Paddles up**”, all will quickly grab the paddle handle of their choice and raise their answers simultaneously.
8. After the “**Paddles up**” call has been made, no paddle may be exchanged for another paddle.
9. If a quizzer's paddle is raised late, the quizzer is disqualified from that question.
10. At the “**Paddles down**” command, quizzers must lower their paddles. After all paddles have been lowered, the quiz master will announce the correct answer. Quizzers restack their paddles.
11. There will be 12 Multiple Choice questions asked from each book. Each individual quizzer is awarded 10 points for each correct answer.

Individual Speed Quizzing

1. One or two quizzers per team, from each book, may compete at one time in speed quizzing.
2. Quizzers will receive their quiz button and be able to test it before starting.
3. Speed questions will not be repeated unless the quizmaster deems it necessary.
4. Help from the audience may result in the question being disqualified, even if the answer is correct.
5. Competitors having two wrong answers in the speed quiz are ineligible to answer additional questions. Another quizzer, however, may be substituted.
6. The quizmaster prefaces each question with the word “**question.**” No talking is allowed by the audience, coaches or quizzers from the word “**question**” until after the head judge announces the ruling as correct or incorrect.
7. After the quiz master has asked the complete question and **no quizzer responds in 10 seconds**, time is called and the next question given. (There are no replacement questions when no one responds.)
8. When a quizzer buzzes in, the quiz master will stop reading, even if it’s in the middle of the question. (The quizzer buzzing in first will have to give a correct, specific answer to the question based on what was read.)
9. The quiz master will ask the number that buzzed in first to stand. A microphone will be brought over to the quizzer. The quiz master will say, “**You may answer.**” The quizzer then has **10 seconds** to say a word to start their answer. After they start answering, the quizzer has **30 seconds to finish** their answer. Grace may be extended for longer answers. However, the quizzer should indicate within 10 seconds if he or she cannot answer, thereby avoiding unnecessary delays and embarrassment.
10. When a speed question has been answered, the quizmaster will ask, “**Is that your answer?**” Only when the quizzer answers “yes,” or time runs out, will the question be ruled correct or incorrect with the head judge saying, “**That is a correct answer,**” or, “**I’m sorry, that is an incorrect answer.**” A correct answer earns **20 points** but an incorrect answers result in **-10 points**.
11. If the first quizzer responding is incorrect, the next quizzer buzzing in will be given the opportunity to answer the question for **10 points**. An incorrect answer results in **- 5 points**. The Quizmaster will reread the question in its entirety and then the quizzer has **5 seconds** to begin their answer.
12. Any clubber answering three questions correctly “quizzes out,” is awarded an **extra 20 points** and cannot answer additional questions. Substitution for that team member is allowed in such a situation.
13. Questions asked (other than Scripture quotations or for a specific word/phrase) may be answered in the quizzer’s own words, but must be close to what the handbook states. The judges determine whether anything important to the meaning has been left out or altered.
14. If a quizzer corrects himself or herself in the process of giving their answer or gives two answers, the last answer the quizzer gives will be the answer that is judged right or wrong.
15. Answers that contain too much unneeded information may be considered incorrect, even if the correct answer is included.

(See types of Questions on the last page.)

Staff for Quizzing

Chain of Command

- Quizmaster
- Head Judge
- Judges/Room Monitor/Timers/Head Scorekeeper/Scorekeepers
- Team Coaches

Each church must provide at least two workers who are acquainted with the quiz rules. Staffing in complete uniform is at the discretion of the event specialist. Each staff member must arrive at the time designated by the event specialist.

Arkansas Awana® T&T Bible Quizzing

Event Specialist

1. Makes sure facility and equipment are ready for the quiz.
2. Lines up and confirms staff members.
3. Lines up teams in the given area and sends acceptance to the teams with information on the Bible Quiz time, place and other information.
4. Keeps record of the teams registered and checks in each team at the quiz meet.
5. Collects completed **Current Awana Clubs Parental Consent and Release of Liability** forms for every quizzer.

Quizmaster

1. Conducts the quiz program.
2. Maintains full authority over the quiz.
3. Reads the quiz questions.
4. Assist the head judge in any decision concerning any contested questions or answers.

Head Judge\Judges

1. Checks to make sure the quizmaster reads the questions correctly and clearly.
2. Helps determine whether a quizzer's answer is correct or incorrect in the speed quizzing.
3. Resets the buzzing system after each answered speed question.
4. Assists the head judge in any decision concerning speed quizzing and any contested questions or answers.
5. Head judge announces whether each speed question is ruled as correct or incorrect.
6. Head judge makes the final decision concerning any questions or answers that are appealed.

Timer

Tracks the length of times according to the Multiple Choice and Speed quizzing rules.

Head Scorekeeper\Scorekeepers

1. Record the points of those quizzers assigned to them throughout the quiz.
2. Let's the quiz master know when a quizzer has given 3 correct or 2 incorrect speed answers.
3. Report their totaled scores to the head scorekeeper.
4. Head scorekeeper records the points for teams and individuals in preparation for the award ceremony.

Preparing teams for Bible Quizzing

1. Pray for your quizzers. Pray that the truths they are studying will have an impact on their lives!
2. Select coaches to work with all prospective quizzers.
3. Thoroughly review the materials and design practice questions and schedule. (Help is available for this through the Quiz event specialist.)
4. Select the quizzers as soon as possible. Once quizzers are established, place them into teams on a roster sheet.
5. Explain the quiz rules to the quizzers so they know what to expect.
6. Work with the quizzers to be sure they really understand the material they have memorized.
7. Instruct the quizzers to know what is required for passing every section of the Discoveries or Challenges the quiz questions will be coming from. That includes verses and references (word-perfect), books of the Bible, Bible reading questions and definitions, etc.
8. Consider challenging another church to a quiz for extra practice.
9. Drill the quizzers in the both types of quizzing. Make sure you adhere to the quizzing rules given in this rulebook.
10. Attend coaches training at an Awana Conference as the opportunity is given.
