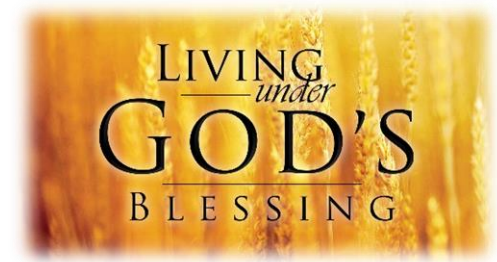

SERMON NOTES

Introduction: Cain and Abel Genesis 4

I. The Human Family Begins Gen 4:1-2

- A. Cain is born, he becomes a gardener
- B. Abel is born, he is a farmer

II. The Human Family Worships Gen 4:3-5

- A. Cain brought an offering of vegetables
- B. Abel brought an offering of the first of his flock and fat
- C. Adonai accepted Abel's offering (Mt 23:35, Heb 11:4)
- D. Adonai rejected Cain's offering

III. The Human Family Deals with Sin Gen 4:5-8

- A. Cain becomes angry and showed it
- B. God questions his anger and says, If you are doing what is good, shouldn't you hold your head high? And if you don't do what is good, sin is crouching at the door
- C. God states, but you can rule over it.
- D. Cain had words with his brother
- E. Cain asks Abel to come to a field and kills him 1 John 3:12

IV. The Human Family Deals with Sin's Consequences Gen 4:9-14

- A. God confronts Cain with a question
- B. Cain answers with a question
