Thank you to all who have collected these over the past.

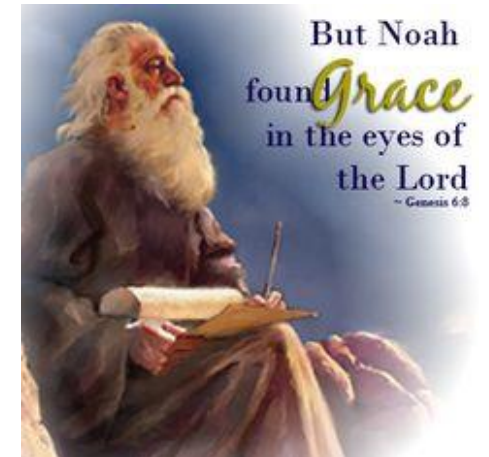

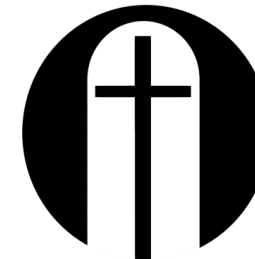
