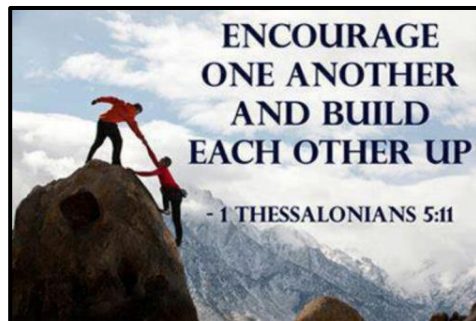
NATURAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT (NCD) SURVEY –
